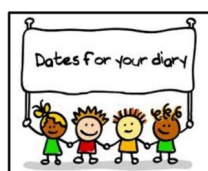

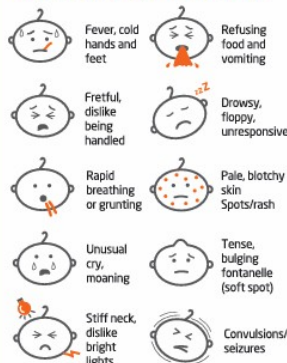
Symptoms can appear in any order. Some may not appear at all. Early symptoms can include:
