<p>Continue developing positive attitudes about the differences between people.</p>	<p>Ensure that resources reflect the diversity of life in modern Britain.</p> <p>Encourage children to talk about the differences they notice between people, whilst also drawing their attention to similarities between different families and communities.</p> <p>Answer their questions and encourage discussion.</p> <p>Suggestion: talk positively about different appearances, skin colours and hair types. Celebrate and value cultural, religious and community events and experiences.</p> <p>Help children to learn each other's names, modelling correct pronunciation.</p>	<p>Same, different</p> <p>Vocabulary related to family members - family, mum, dad, grandma, grandad, brothers, sisters, aunty, uncle, cousins, step mum, step dad etc.</p> <p>Vocabulary related to features -hair colours, eye colours, skin colours etc.</p> <p>Vocabulary related to children's ethnic origins and/or the associated countries.</p> <p>Children's names</p>
